Basic Information:

- 100 Launch

Number of Coach Specific Training Hours:

- 8 x 120 minute class sessions (online) 20 hours
- 1 x 120 minute phone-based, recorded triads (reviews by Instructor)
- 6 x 10 minute videos (pre-work for class sessions)
- 6 writing assignments (submitted for review)

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Website Description:

100 Launch is the first required course in CoachNet's Essential ACC Pathway toward an International Coach Federation training . This course is built on the model that CoachNet has used since 1999, and is designed to get you started coaching with solid skills. 100 Launch introduces the fundamentals on which the entire Integrated Coach Training approach is built.

Completing 100 Launch with a credentialed CoachNet trainer gives you 20 hours of coach specific training. Be sure to select the cohort you want so that the training works in your schedule.

- 20 Hours, delivered fully online; 8 weeks of sessions, 2 hours in each online session
- 100 Launch runs on Wednesdays from 4-6pm EST or Thursdays Noon-2pm EST
- Emphasis on the basics of coaching: Listening, Powerful Questions, and Action Steps
- Receive feedback on recorded coaching conversations from experienced coaches to learn what to do (and sometimes what NOT to do)
- Practice coaching triads in live sessions 4 and 8 plus one final triad after session 8 that is recorded and reviewed by a CoachNet Trainer. You will also complete quizzes writing assignments in between sessions
- Optional final coaching conversation with a CoachNet trainer to receive personal and specific feedback on your coaching
- All 11 ICF Core Coaching Competencies are covered

Course Objectives:

The objectives for this course are:

- Understand the full coach development arc as CoachNet applies it
- Equip yourself with a basic skill set for informal & formal coaching
- Practice (with feedback)
- Experience the ICF Core Competencies and Code of Ethics
- Conduct formal and informal coaching conversations and begin to understand formal coaching relationships

Required Student Resources:

To successfully complete 100 Launch you will need:

- A reliable internet connection
- A reliable telephone
- A copy of the 100 Launch Participant's Sessions Guide (8 sessions - Download on website under My Courses)
- An email address
- Word processing software to submit final assignments in Microsoft Word format

Course Schedule/Outline/Calendar of Events:

Your 100 Launch will follow the following formats online training for eight 2 hour sessions.

- Sessions 1-3 & 5-7 are live interactive learning
- Sessions 4 & 8 are a live practice triad exercise where you'll coach and be coached. You'll also receive feedback from the instructor and your peers

100 Launch also includes follow up triad and writing work, which is due 30 days after the last class. 100 Launch begins online 3 times per year. The Final Triad is recorded and evaluated by the CoachNet Team according to standards from the International Coach Federation as if you were submitting it with a credential application.
